

Mayor Ed Sisson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Also present were Councilmembers Bill Raley, Robert Jurca, Mary Cooper, and Ray Penick and Acting City Manager Glen Black. A meeting notice was posted in the south window at City Hall at least twenty-four hours prior to the meeting.

**Pledge of Allegiance**

The Mayor led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Changes to the Agenda**

There were none.

**Minutes**

It was moved by Councilmember Penick and seconded by Councilmember Jurca to approve the minutes of the February 17, 2015 regular meeting as submitted by the Clerk. All in favor, motion carried.

**Citizen Comments**

Fran Goetz, 1053 Grand Avenue, commented on dogs running at large within the City of Delta.

**Delta County Historical Society Civil War Commemoration Request**

Keith Lucy, 717 Renee Street, with the Delta County Historical Society presented Council with information for the Civil War Commemoration being held on May 8, 9, and 10, 2015. He asked Council to consider submitting a sponsorship for the event.

**Public Hearing: Special Events Permit Application; Delta Area Chamber of Commerce**

The Mayor recessed the regular meeting and convened a public hearing.

The Clerk reported that the Delta Area Chamber of Commerce has submitted an application for Special Events Liquor Permits for their two events to be held at Bill Heddles Recreation Center. The first event is for their Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet being held on March 28, 2015. The application specifies that they plan to sell alcoholic beverages from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. The second event is scheduled on April 17, 2015. The application specifies that they plan to sell alcoholic beverages from 4:00pm to 9:30pm. A sign was posted at the site as required by law and no comments have been received.

The Mayor closed the public hearing and reconvened the regular meeting.

It was moved by Councilmember Jurca and seconded by Councilmember Raley to approve the special event permit application for the Delta Area Chamber of Commerce for March 28, 2015 and April 17, 2015. All in favor, motion carried.

**Hotel/Restaurant Liquor License Renewal; Daveto's**

The Clerk stated that Daveto's Italian Restaurant has submitted their annual hotel and restaurant liquor license application. The application is complete and all fees have been paid. The police department is recommending renewal.

It was moved by Councilmember Cooper and seconded by Councilmember Penick to approve the hotel/restaurant liquor license renewal for Daveto's Italian Restaurant. All in favor, motion carried.

**Vehicle Purchases**

Utilities Director Steve Glammeyer stated this is the last round of purchases for this year. This purchase includes a new street sweeper, an animal control van, a patrol car, and a pro-gator. He stated the vehicles are listed with the amounts in the spreadsheet provided to Council.

Mayor Sisson questioned if the AWD vehicles are cheaper as they were a few years ago for the patrol car.

Fleet Manager Rod Myers stated that the AWD vehicles were cheaper a few years ago; however, they are not at this time.

Councilmember Cooper questioned how many hours the street sweeper is used a week.

Mr. Myers stated the sweeper is used approximately 16 hours a week.

There was discussion on the different types of street sweepers.

Councilmember Penick stated that all items are under budget and that he appreciates staff's work.

It was moved by Councilmember Penick and seconded by Councilmember Jurca to approve the purchase of the following vehicles/equipment:

- Ford Transit Connet from Hellman Motor Company for \$23,895,
- Ford Taurus/Interceptor from Hellman Motor Company for \$32,050
- Pelican street sweeper from Faris Machinery for \$196,960
- Pro-gator from Potesio Brothers for \$20,958.

All in favor, motion carried.
