The Delta City Council recently adopted new sign regulations. The entire Ordinance may be viewed at www.cityofdelta.net under the news tab. Below are the highlights:

- A sign permit is required for all signs over 6 sq ft. Each lot is allowed two yard signs of 6 sq ft. each, or one swing sign 7 sq ft or less.
- Signs are NOT allowed on sidewalks, utility poles, medians or other rights of way (this includes Political, Yard/Garage Sale signs etc.)
- Signs allowed without a permit—banners or wave flags 25 sq ft or less (limit 2 per lot); balloons less than 24” diameter, pennants.
- All wind-powered devices or other un-permitted signs must be discontinued by October 1, 2016.
- No animated or moving signs that are visible from the public right of way, including moving, swinging, rotating, flashing, blinking or otherwise animated light (except scrolling signs 10 sq ft or less—must have a permit)

Allowed sign square footage is determined by the zoning district and lot frontage.
